Compared to the last report on 7/8/2021: Hay trade remains steady in most areas with some areas slowing. Many producers are moving hay to their yearly buyers, but day to day trade has slowed down. With the recent rainfall and warmer temperatures there has been an increase in the hay supply, which is slowing the demand for some of the higher quality hay. Many producers have completed their 3rd cutting of alfalfa, and with the recent moisture they are looking to have a good 4th cutting soon. Hay trade for the dairy market and grinding hay has slowed some with silage coming in soon. The weather is expected to be warmer and mostly dry in the coming week. The organic grass hay in western Oklahoma is certified USDA Organic.
