Compared to the last report 7/23/2021: Quality hay trade has slowed in most areas. With continued moisture and cooler temperatures there has been an ample supply of hay, making it a buyers market. With widespread rainfall across the state, production will continue, with many expecting a 5th cutting of alfalfa this year. Many producers are yielding less and lower quality hay. Grinding alfalfa prices dropped \$10 per ton, while grass hay prices remain mostly steady. With low milk prices, dairies are switching to cheaper alternatives for the rations such as straw and silage.
