

OKLAHOMA PORK'S ECONOMIC IMPACT

The Oklahoma pork industry provides a purpose, a lifestyle and an income to more than **34,000** Oklahomans employed in their local communities.

Oklahoma exports roughly 2B pounds of pork each year to feed millions across the world. This is equivalent to 5% of total U.S. pork exports.

1 out of every 50

jobs in Oklahoma is supported by the pork industry.

Prior to 1991, swine production was a relatively minor part of the broader Oklahoma agriculture industry. Today, pork has grown to Oklahoma's

largest agricultural enterprise at \$976M.

Cattle ranks first at \$3.27B, and broilers rank third at \$729M.
